

Hold is called when the hallways need to be kept clear, even during class changes.

#### Students:

- Clear the hallways and remain in their room or area until the "All Clear" is announced
- Do business as usual

#### Adults:

- Close and lock door
- · Account for students and adults
- Do business as usual



Secure!
Get inside.
Lock outside
doors.

Secure is called when there is a threat or hazard outside the building.

#### Students:

- Return to inside of building
- Do business as usual

#### Adults:

- Bring everyone indoors
- · Lock outside doors
- Increase situational awareness
- Account for students and adults
- Do business as usual



#### Lockdown! Locks, Lights, Out of Sight

Lockdown is called when there is a threat

or hazard inside the building.

#### Students:

- Move away from sight
- Maintain silence
- Do not open the door

#### Adults:

- Recover students from hallway if possible
- Lock the classroom door
- Turn out the lights
- Move away from sight
- Maintain silence
- Do not open the door
- Prepare to evade or defend



### Evacuate! "To a location"

Evacuate is called to move students and staff from one

location to another.

#### Students:

- Leave stuff behind if required
- If possible, bring your phone
- Follow instructions

#### Adults:

- Bring roll sheet if possible, take Go Bag (unless instructed not to take anything)
- Lead students to evacuation location
- Account for students and adults
- Report injuries or problems using Red Card/Green Card



#### Hold! In your room or area. Clear the halls.

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
